Kapla are gnome planks: small, smooth, pine boards of 8x24x120 millimeters. Playing with KAPLA planks harnesses both body and mind, making it easier for children to learn complex concepts and to improve both motor skills and collaboration. Learning is natural and fun with KAPLA. All classes will have a session in the hall building their constructions. Parents will be able to view the work carried out over the two days before there is a mass 'deconstruction' at 3:30pm.

Out of School Tax Free Child Care

If you or your partner both work and earn between minimum wage and £100,000 per year, you are probably eligible to **save 25%** on Childcare costs with HMRC Tax Free Childcare.

It is very easy to apply and school have already registered. Each month you add funds to your HMRC account and for every £8 you pay, they give you a £2 top up. Payments are then made direct to school by HMRC.

It is quick and easy to upload the voucher to school Spider, and then book in to sessions in exactly the same way as we have always done but instead of paying by card, you use your voucher credit. You can cancel sessions for a refund back to your voucher or make changes up to 24 hours prior to the session just like paying by card.
