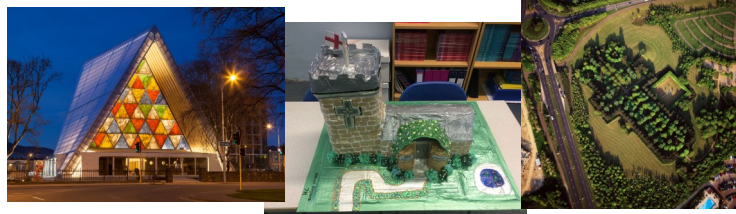


Design Competition


